This one-year, Monday–Friday Bible reading plan follows the **storyline of Scripture** in six major themes rather than a straight-through reading. The goal is to see how God’s redemptive story unfolds—from creation, to Israel, to Jesus, to the church, and finally to the New Creation.

Each week includes:

- **Five readings (Monday–Friday)**
- **One verse for weekly memorization**
- **A one-sentence “Christ-connection” that demonstrates how Jesus is the fulfillment of all Scripture (Luke 24:27).**

Weekends are left open for rest, catch-up, reflection, or sermon-related reading.

PART 1: Creation, Fall, and Promise (Weeks 1-5)
